JOB DESCRIPTION

TITLE: *Applied Welding Technology Instructor*

QUALIFICATIONS:

1. Oklahoma Teaching Certificate/License; or be willing to obtain.
2. Bachelor's degree preferred or must earn within first 5 years of employment.
3. A minimum of 3 years work experience in welding.

PERFORMANCE RESPONSIBILITIES:

1. Develop lesson plans and instructional materials that meet the district's curriculum goals as well as the individual needs of each pupil.
2. Translate lesson plans into learning experiences that effectively utilize the available time for instruction.
3. Establish and maintain standards of pupil behavior needed to achieve a functional learning atmosphere in the classroom.
4. Evaluate pupil's academic and social growth, keep appropriate records, and prepare reports relating to pupil's progress.
5. Communicate with parents, if applicable, through conferences and other means to discuss pupil progress and interpret the school program.
6. Identify pupil needs and cooperate with other professional staff members in assessing and helping pupils solve health, attitude, and learning problems.
7. Create an effective environment for learning through functional and attractive displays, bulletin boards, and interest centers.
8. Maintain professional competence through inservice education activities provided by the district and self-selected professional growth activities.
9. Select and requisition books and instructional aids; maintain required inventory records.
10. Supervise pupils in out-of-classroom activities during the assigned working day.
11. Develop and encourage a viable Career Tech Student Organization (Skills USA) for his/her area.
12. Participate in curriculum development programs as required.
13. Participate in faculty committees and sponsorship of pupil activities.
14. Develop and enforce safety procedures for all equipment in his/her program that could pose a danger to students.
15. Establish and/or maintain an active advisory committee as per ODCTE requirements.
16. Work with the Job Placement Specialist and show a constant concern for students and past students to find and keep jobs.
17. Maintain ties with his/her trade area and engage in update training as per school policy so as to stay current with the technology in the field.
